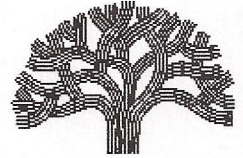

RE: CALDECOTT FOURTH BORE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT-FUNDED PROJECTS

Dear Caldecott Tunnel Stakeholders,

As you know, the drilling of the "Fourth Bore" of the Caldecott Tunnel is underway. Prior to the start of this project, the City of Oakland reached a settlement with Caltrans requiring that \$8 million be made available to implement projects within the City of Oakland as mitigation for the expanded tunnel.

You are invited to a public meeting to review and discuss the projects that are proposed to be funded with the City of Oakland settlement money:

Location: Kaiser Elementary School, 25 South Hill Court (Hiller Highlands Neighborhood)
Date & Time: Monday, November 8, 7:00 p.m.

The proposed projects were developed with community representatives as part of the original settlement agreement with Caltrans. Walk Audits of the neighborhoods potentially impacted by the tunnel were conducted with community residents in June and July of this year to elicit further community input. The City of Oakland also contracted with an independent consultant to analyze and cost-estimate the projects. This process resulted in the project list which will be presented on November 8. A map of the area, locations of proposed projects and links to fact sheets describing each potential project will be available online at www.fourthbore.org one week before the meeting.
